

Auction Bidder's Access to Texas Stadium
Only Large Items Requiring Contractor to Remove May be Viewed
Irving, Texas

1. All Visitors must be at least 18 years of age and possess a valid driver's license.
2. All Visitors (or their Company) must be registered with City of Irving Purchasing Department as a prospective bidder for the City of Irving (Texas) Stadium Auction.
3. Stadium access will be **BY APPOINTMENT ONLY** between August 7 to August 21st during the following times, subject to change:
Monday: 1 pm to 5 pm
Tuesday:: 1 pm to 5 pm
Wednesday: 11 am to 5 pm
Thursday: 11 am to 5 pm
Friday: no scheduled access
To make an appointment, e-mail djaneway@cityofirving.org and request a specific time. The appointment time will be confirmed by return e-mail. **DO NOT SHOW UP AT THE STADIUM WITHOUT A CONFIRMED APPOINTMENT. THE POLICE ON-DUTY WILL NOT LET YOU IN.**
4. All Visitors must sign a liability waiver. The waiver form must be notarized. You may bring the signed waiver form with you to the stadium, you may e-mail the form prior to the visit or you may fax the form to 972-721-4668. **YOU WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO ENTER THE STADIUM WITHOUT A VALID WAIVER FORM ON FILE WITH THE CITY.** All Visitors must be escorted by City of Irving personnel, or their designated representatives.
5. Visitors must wear appropriate attire at all times (including in vehicles once on site). This includes:
 - a. Full length pants
 - b. Shirts with at least 4" sleeves
 - c. Durable work type shoes. Shoes must cover the entire foot completely, have sturdy soles, and no stiletto type heels. Tennis shoes are not acceptable.
6. Wear hard hat, safety glasses, and safety vests at all time. Glasses must be OSHA approved glasses (personal sun glasses and prescription glasses may not meet this requirement.)
7. Any photography must be specifically approved by the office of Corporate Communication.
8. Directions to Stadium: The stadium is located at the intersection of SH 183, Loop 12 and SH 114. You will enter the site at Gate 1 which is located at the southwest corner of the site at the intersection of SH183 and Loop 12. Please see the attached map.

No exceptions can be made to this policy.

THAT I, _____ of _____ County, _____, for and in consideration of being allowed to enter City property and stadium formerly known as Texas Stadium [the "Premise"], do hereby release, indemnify, acquit and forever discharge the State of Texas and the City of Irving, Texas, their agents, servants, officers, both elected and appointed, employees, and volunteers from any and all liability, actions, causes of actions, claims, demands or suits whatsoever, which I, my heirs, executors or administrators, may now or hereafter have or claim to have, on account of or arising out of personal injuries or damage to my person or property, or involving any impairment or damage to any right, accruing to me because of or in any way related to my entry upon the Premise.

I recognize and have been informed that the Premise is an active construction site that can be dangerous and hazardous to employees and visitors. I recognize and have been informed that the structure on the Premise is no longer is active use, may not have all warning devices in place, may have hidden defects, includes stairs without handrails, has limited artificial lighting, has discontinued systems normally found in such structures. I understand that I enter the Premise at my own risk of all defects whether mentioned here, whether known or unknown.

I further warrant that no promise, statement, threat or agreement not herein expressed has been made, and that I fully understand this instrument and I execute it with full knowledge of its meaning, having first read it carefully.

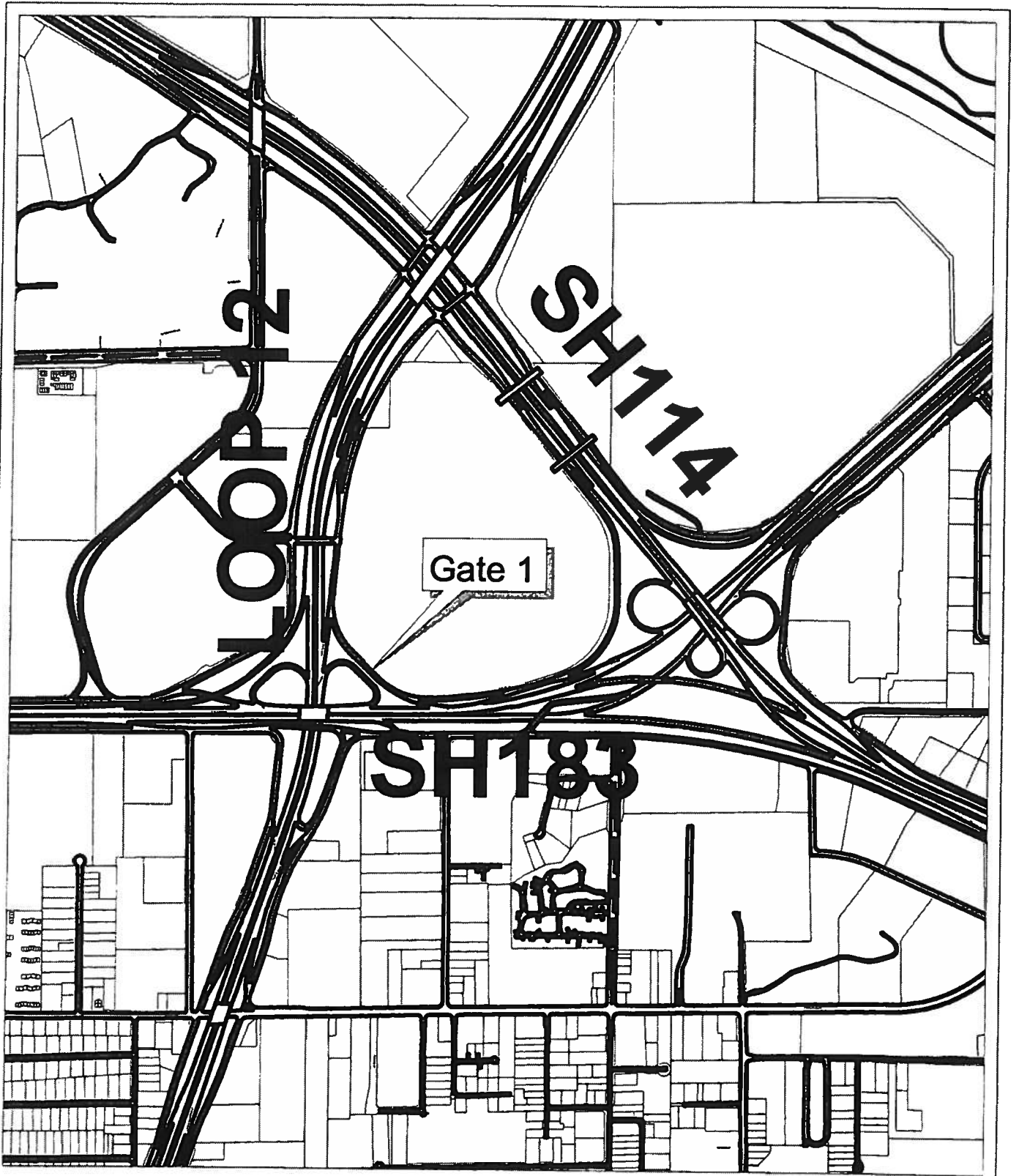

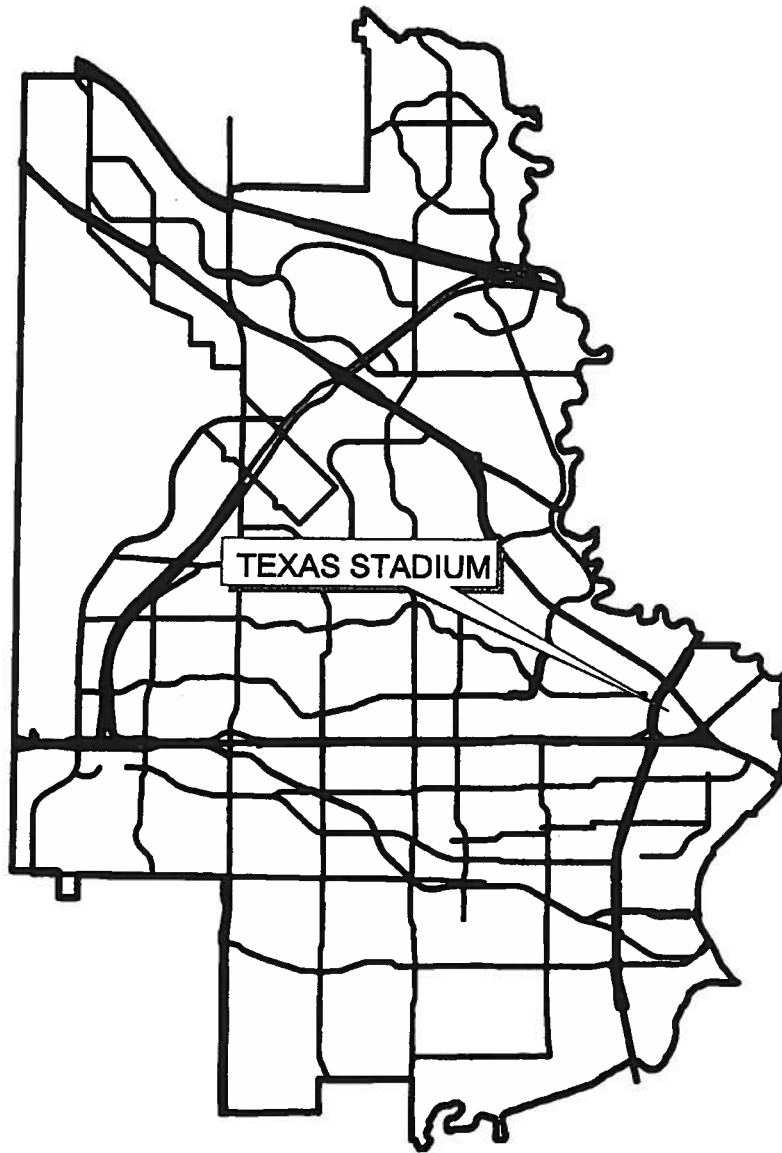
GIS MAP:
